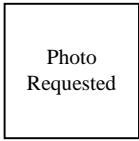

MBC STATEMENT OF FAITH

1. I believe in the entire Bible, consisting of the Old and New Testament as verbally inspired of God, and inerrant in the original writings, and that they are of supreme and final authority in faith and life.
2. I believe in one God, eternally existing in three persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
3. I believe that Jesus Christ was begotten of the Holy Spirit, and born of the virgin Mary, and is true God and man.
4. I believe that man was created in the image of God, that he sinned and thereby incurred not only physical death but also that spiritual death which is separation from God; and that all human beings are born with a sinful nature, and in the case of those who reach moral responsibility, become sinners in thought, word and deed.
5. I believe that the Lord Jesus Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures as a representative and substitutionary sacrifice; and that all who believe in Him are justified on the grounds of his shed blood.
6. I believe in the resurrection of the crucified body of our Lord, in His ascension into Heaven, and in His present life there for us as High Priest and advocate.
7. I believe that any moment the Rapture of the saved may occur, when “the Lord himself shall descend from Heaven” to catch up his people to meet Him “in the air”.
8. I believe in the personal, bodily and premillennial return of our Lord Jesus Christ to set up His kingdom upon the Earth.
9. I believe that salvation is by grace through faith, and that all who receive by faith the Lord Jesus Christ are born again of the Holy Spirit and thereby become children of God.
10. I believe in the bodily resurrection of the just and unjust, the everlasting blessedness of the saved, and the everlasting conscious punishment of the lost.
11. I believe it to be the supreme responsibility of the disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ to make his Gospel known to all men.
